The professor shall speak on topics of contemporary relevance in the field of Sanskrit learning and research at the Department of Sanskrit Studies, Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Educational and Research Institute (RKMVERI), Belur Math

Prof. Paturi, former visiting professor, University of Chicago, US, holds a doctoral degree from the University of Hyderabad for research in *Myth Criticism of 16th Century Narrative Poems*. Presently he is the Director of the *Indic Academy of Sanskrit Indological Studies*, and *Inter-University Centre for Indic Knowledge Systems*, Hyderabad. He is also as a member of the board of studies at several esteemed Universities. Long experience in education, wide exposure to modern trends in academics, up-to-date knowledge of emerging challenges in the field of Sanskrit studies and research have all rendered him a rare blend of the traditional and the modern in one.
